

Concept Note and Guidelines

A. BACKGROUND

The Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization (SEAMEO) will mark its 57th Anniversary on 30 November 2022. This year, the SEAMEO Secretariat organises series of impactful activities for its 57th celebration encompassing the theme "SEAMEO CARES: Building Forward Stronger (BFS) in SEAMEO Member Countries".

SEAMEO is honored to invite all **youth aged 15 to 23 of Southeast Asian nationalities** to present their creative ideas and sensational findings in the **2nd SEAMEO Youth Action (SEAYA) Contest** which is in line with the theme **"VUCA World"**.

B. OBJECTIVES

- Provide an inspirational knowledge management platform and experiences exchange among youth and individuals in the region
- Identify the challenges and opportunities faced by the youth and capture their ideas parallel to the VUCA World; and
- Share the ideas and voices of the youth to policy makers and educators in the region to upgrade digital education in the region

C. THEME: VUCA World

VUCA stands for <u>Volatility</u>, <u>Uncertainty</u>, <u>Complexity</u>, and <u>Ambiguity</u>. The COVID-19 pandemic has showed that we have a VUCA World. A VUCA world has impacts to our **life**, work or studies. However, we need to adapt and cope with the rapid changes in this VUCA world.

In line with this, SEAMEO would like to explore young people's responses on how they will thrive in a **VUCA world** by providing them a platform to showcase their thoughts and solutions through vlog, storytelling, dance and song in 3-5 minutes.

D. CATEGORIES OF CONTEST

All youth aged 15-23 years old with the Southeast Asian nationalities are invited to create and submit a short video clip of 3 to 5 minutes maximum with authentic creative contents presenting their positive responses on how they will thrive in a VUCA world. The three accepted content categories of the creative video clips are as follows:

- 1. Vlog (video blog)
- 2. Storytelling
- 3. Dance and Song

E. QUALIFICATIONS OF THE APPLICANTS

- Applicant can be an individual or a team (maximum 10 people/team).
- Age 15-23 years old
- Southeast Asian nationality, namely Bruneian, Burmese, Cambodian, Filipino, Indonesian, Laotian, Malaysian, Singaporean, Thai, Timorese, Vietnamese
- One applicant/group can apply for one category only.

F. GUIDELINES FOR VIDEO CLIPS PRODUCTION

Interested applicants must follow the rules and guidelines as follows to be eligible to join the contest.

- Applicants should follow/subscribe to the SEAMEO Secretariat's social media channels.

- Applicants should like and share the #2ndSEAYA post on the SEAMEO Secretariat's Facebook to the applicants' Facebook and set as a public post.
- One applicant can apply for one category only.

Video Content

- An individual or a team can perform in the video.
- The acceptable file format is MP4
- The video length is limited to 3-5 minutes.
- The content should be relevant to the theme, original, and creative.
- The message in the video should provide solutions in addressing the VUCA Word.
- It is recommended that you compose the song on your own related to the theme particularly for the singing category.
- The content should be in **English**. A non-English video clips should contain an **English subtitle** and ensure that the voice and the text are **synchronized**.
- Contents promoting/containing any malicious, violent, and similar contents (both video and audio) that are against the laws and moral norms will be disqualified.

Video Introduction and Closing

- Add an opening scene for the video clip of vlog, storytelling, dance and song.
- You can make your credit title containing all of the casts and crews at a closing scene.

Copyrights Regulation

- The applicants acknowledge and guarantee that their original work was created solely for this contest. It does not infringe on copyrights, trademarks, and the rights of privacy, publicity, or intellectual property rights of any person or entity.
- If you are using other people's content, make sure it is free-license content.
- Concerning that, all of the video clips will be uploaded on the YouTube site.
 Therefore, all of the video clips should be defined clearly according to the Creative Commons license to avoid being taken down by YouTube.
- As for License and Legal on YouTube, you can read at https://bit.ly/youtube legal.
- The SEAMEO Secretariat shall use your video for educational/non-commercial purposes only. Your video will be one of the SEAMEO Secretariat contents. The SEAMEO Secretariat shall follow the attribution in your video clips.

G. HOW TO SUBMIT?

- 1. Upload your video clip (MP4 format) on YouTube and,

H. JUDGING CRITERIA

Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

1.	Relevance to the theme and provide Clear Solutions in the message	40%
2.	Clarity and Creativity of the message	40%
3.	Technical Execution	20%

The decision of the judging committee shall be final.

I. AWARDS

The judging committee will select the 1st winner and two (2) runners-up for each category (Vlog, Storytelling, Dance and Song).
