Theme: “Investing on Lifelong Education For the Future of Southeast Asians”

GUIDELINES on ARTICLE SUBMISSION

1. Articles should highlight perspectives from relevant local, national, regional, international or comparative research papers in the following **Theme and Sub-Themes**. The SEAMEO Technical Committee, who will be tasked to review the submitted articles, reserves the right to include a paper for consideration in a sub-theme other than the one you may identify, if deemed appropriate.

Theme: Investing on Lifelong Education for the Future of Southeast Asians

Sub-themes:

- (1) Ensuring the employability of youths and various models of skills;
- (2) Improving access to quality educational opportunities for the disadvantaged and the unreached; and
- (3) Building resilience on disruptions, such as pandemics, internal and external wars and displacements and natural disasters.

2. It is recommended that articles follow the same format used at other international meetings and in journals. An acceptable structure for an article should include background of the study, methods used in the study, results and conclusion. Details of each component are as follows:
 - **Background and Introduction:** A statement of the hypothesis or research question.
 - **Methods:** An explanation of the study design and experimental methods used in the study.
 - **Results:** A concise summary of the major findings of the experiment or study. Authors should provide sufficient data to permit evaluation by the Technical Committee.
 - **Conclusion and Recommendations:** Summary of the overall findings, the importance of the study and perhaps recommendations for further study.

Articles accepted will be published in the SEAMEO JOURNAL 2022 to be distributed to all authors and available on the website of the SEAMEO Secretariat.

3. The first page of the submission should only contain the abstract (Background, Methods, Results, and Conclusion) and should identify a preferred sub-theme, track and abstract category. It should not bear any marks identifiable to the author or authors. The abstract must be no longer than **300 words** in English. The second page should contain the author name, title, affiliations, and location (city, state, and country) of each author; indicate the corresponding author using email address of the corresponding author. In formatting the text of the abstract, a standard font, such as 12pt, Arial should be used.
4. Article submissions will be opened from **1 September to 1 October 2022**. Authors are advised to ensure that their articles meet the criteria and guidelines as indicated above. All articles should be submitted to journal2022@seameo.org. **Initial notice of acceptance or rejection will be sent to the submitting authors by 31 October 2022**. Questions regarding the preparation and submission of articles may be directed to the same email address as well.
5. By submitting an article, the author/s retain the copyright of the paper but agree to allow publication of submitted articles and related information on the author in SEAMEO JOURNAL 2022.
