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Prof. Pranati Panda is a Professor and Head of the Department of School and Non-Formal Education and also heading a dedicated Unit on School Standards and Evaluation at the National Institute of Educational Planning and Administration (NIEPA), New Delhi, India. She has more than three decades of teaching, research, and training engagement in several premier national organizations in different research and faculty positions of National Institute of Public Cooperation and Child Development (NIPCED), National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT), and National Institute of Educational Planning and Administration (NIEPA).

Prof. Panda has a broad range of experiences, from field-level practices to national-level policy formulations and implementations.
