

Dr. Rohizani Yaakub is a senior lecturer and Associate Professor at the School of Educational Studies, Universiti Sains Malavsia. Her major research areas include Curriculum and Pedagogy, Teacher Studies, and Global Citizenship Education. She has supervised 12 Phd theses. 5 MA theses and 57 M.Ed dissertations. She held posts as Principal Investigator for many research projects and has contributed significantly as consultant for the Curriculum Development Division, Ministry of Education Malaysia on various capacities. Publication wise, AP. Dr. Rohizani Yaakub has published 8 books, 8 monographs, 30 teaching and learning modules, and 40 journal articles. AP.
